Dear Parents and Guardians,

Our Via Dolorosa celebration is tomorrow April 13, 2017. Here are a few reminders:

First, the weather. The forecast (remember we live in Michigan) calls for a 50% chance of rain in the morning. That could mean 2:00 AM, 7:00 AM or 11:00 AM. We will monitor the weather closely. There could be a chance that we walk earlier, like we did 2 years ago, or the walk could be delayed for later in the morning.

This would be a great time, if you haven't already, to [sign up for the Remind App](#) as we will be sending text alerts letting you know where we stand. It would also be a good idea to send your child with appropriate clothing in case we run into some light rain while we walk (rain boots, raincoats, umbrellas).

In the meantime, prayers and rain dances (backwards of course!) are welcomed and appreciated.

Finally a few other reminders:

- Drop off is from 7:50-8:10 am at the Middle School Campus
- Students must wear their "We Are One" or "Forming Saints To Serve All" T-shirts. Athletic shoes and appropriate walking attire is also recommended.
- No backpacks please!
- For students who didn't order a sack lunch make sure you bring one with your name on it. We will transport those to the elementary building.
- If you offered to help with the Seder Meal preparation please report to the elementary kitchen upon arrival from the walk.
- For those students who are not getting picked up at 1:00 pm child care will be available. Pickup at 3:15 pm will be at the elementary building. Childcare is open until 6:00 pm.

The shuttle bus will be running in the morning with a departure time of 7:40 am from the elementary campus. If your child is coming to morning Saints Club they will be sent to the middle school on the shuttle bus. If you are not comfortable with your child riding the shuttle bus please contact the school office to make other arrangements.
