

Dear ASA Middle School Families,

We are looking forward to a great new school year! As teachers meet and engage in final preparations this week, we want to share a few important details and updates.

Shuttle:

Students can be dropped off at the elementary campus until 7:40 a.m. to ride the shuttle bus to the middle school. Students dropped off at the middle school at 7:40 a.m. will wait outside (except on inclement weather days) until the middle school doors open at 7:50 a.m. The first bell of the day is at 8:00 a.m.

At the end of the day the shuttle bus will pick up shuttle students about 3:30 p.m. at the middle school and will take them to the elementary campus for pick up or Eagles Club.

Car line review:



For the safety of all students and staff:

- 1) Park in the red line if you exit at 4 Mile.
- 2) Park in the yellow line if you exit at Assumption to Elmdale.
- 3) First two cars stop at the end of the red and yellow arrows.
- 4) No cars move until all students are loaded. (Similar to the Elementary Campus.)

- 5) If you need to come into the school park in the island between the school and ball field (circled in green.)
