MAP Testing

MAP testing begins next Tuesday, September 12. All students in grades 2-8 participate in [NWEA Measuring Academic Progress Growth](#) testing in Reading, Language Usage and Math. At ASA we test in the Fall, and then again in the Spring to measure the growth of our students. If there is a particular area of concern we may test selected groups in a particular subject mid-year as well. This is not a test for which your students can study, it simply measures what they know at this time. You can assist your students by making sure they get a good night's sleep the night before the test, and eat a good breakfast that morning. We also ask that, whenever possible, please do not pull your children from class for appointments during their scheduled testing time. A testing schedule by grade has been attached to this message for your convenience.
