2018-2019 Enrollment Reminder

Enrollment is now open to returning families and siblings of currently enrolled students. If you have not already started the enrollment process for next year, please do so sooner rather than later. There are waiting lists for multiple age levels, so please don't wait. Your child's spot is not guaranteed until the enrollment process is complete. You can start the process by completing the Intent to Enroll form. Please take a look at the Enrollment Checklist sent home to make sure you don't miss any steps along the way. When the enrollment process is complete for your child, you will receive an enrollment confirmation email from ASA.

Enrollment Facts on February 23

- 14% of current students have not responded to the Intent to Enroll.
- Of the 86% who have responded: 153/247 have completed their Smart Tuition re-enrollment and 128/247 have turned in their Enrollment Agreements.
- We enrolled 12 new students this week who are siblings of current students.
- We have 16 students on our waiting list.
