MAP Testing Coming Up

The [MAP testing](#) window begins April 23rd, and extends through May 18. Students in grades 2-8 are tested in math, language usage and reading during that time. These scores will be compared to the MAP scores from the Fall to measure growth, and identify areas to be addressed. You can help by making sure your child gets a good night's sleep and eats a nutritious breakfast before coming to school. Please also try to schedule appointments at times when your child is not testing. A testing schedule by grade is attached to this message. In addition, it can be found on

the ASA calendar for each day. The grades testing that day are included in the details. Just click on the event to see them.
