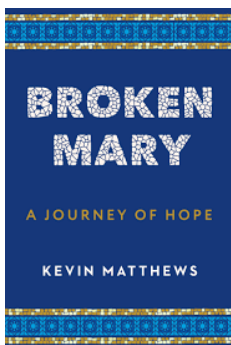


Celebrate Mary, our Mother, with Kevin Matthews!
