


Something exciting is coming to one of our parishes!



At Saint Isidore's next week, Eugene and Jeanine Hettich, two seminarians (Vincenzo Caruso and Stephen Sonatakke), and a single man (Alann Gutierrez) will offer a series of talks (catechesis) that have deeply impacted and helped them in their lives.

Eugene and Jeanine had a profound experience of the love of God through these catecheses in their home parishes in New York and New Jersey respectively. While both were cradle Catholics from weekly Mass-attending families, their Christianity had been something superficial: there was a disconnect between their faith and their lives. When their marriage entered a profound crisis that threatened to destroy it, Christ rescued and reconciled them. Humanly speaking, the situation was impossible, but these catecheses were the catalyst for rebuilding their marriage. They have 4 boys (Richard, Samuel, Ignatius and Ambrose) aged 1 ½ years to 8yrs old.

Everyone is invited and encouraged to attend. All are welcome, Catholic, not Catholic, practicing, not practicing, etc.

If you are suffering, doubting, depressed, lukewarm, lonely, looking to deepen your faith, or simply curious, come! Jesus Christ passes in our midst with this catechesis.
