1. Complete a [Smart Aid online application](#). **This is required for any family applying for financial aid.**
2. Request funds from your home parish. Please [complete the Parish Financial Aid Application Form](#) by **March 15, 2021**. This form should be returned to ASA. You must have completed the [Parish Investment Request Form](#) before requesting additional aid (if applicable).
3. If you are still in need of additional support, or are not a member of a Catholic parish, [please complete the ASA Financial Aid Application Form](#) by **May 1, 2021**. ASA only considers assistance requests after parish assistance has been requested (if applicable).
