ASA will be retiring many student Chromebooks this summer. Most of these HP Chromebook 11A EE G6 models are in working order, however they do show wear and tear from daily student use over the last seven years. We will be selling them "as is" for \$50 each - with no post-sale support. It's important to note that they are only scheduled to continue receiving security and feature updates until Spring 2027. We won't know exactly how many are in good enough working order to sell until after the school year ends. The expectation is to make them available for purchase in early August.
