Dear ASA Families,

This school year ASA is continuing to partner with West Catholic, our food service provider, to offer breakfast through the National School Lunch Program. Breakfast is available on school days only to students in our toddler through 8th-grade programs. Breakfast is available to students at the cost listed below:

- \$2.50 standard price
- \$0.30 for reduced-price students
- Free for students who qualify

Breakfast is charged to your child's Infinite Campus account just as lunch is. Three components will be in each breakfast: a grain, a fruit, and milk.

While the cost and lunch components will remain the same for all programs, the logistics of how to order breakfast and when it is available will vary based on your child's age.

At the Lower Campus, all breakfasts will be available in the office starting at 7:30 a.m. until 8:05 a.m.

- Toddler and preschool parents should stop in the office with their child on the way to sign their child into their classroom and purchase their child's breakfast. If your child arrives before 7:30 a.m., the adult dropping off the child in the toddler or preschool room must inform the staff member that his/her child needs breakfast, and ASA staff will make sure the child receives their breakfast at 7:30 a.m. Toddler and preschool students will be able to eat breakfast, whether purchased at school or parent-provided, until 8:15 a.m. ASA will continue to provide mid-morning snacks for our toddler and preschool students.
- Upper Campus students attending morning Eagles Club child care are able to purchase breakfast at 7:30 a.m. and are able to eat until 7:45 a.m., when they must prepare to board the shuttle bus. A parent/guardian must inform the staff member after signing in if their child will be purchasing breakfast that day. Please note that no open milk containers or food containers are allowed on the shuttle bus. Students may not eat on the bus.
- K-2 students attending morning Saints Club will be able to purchase a breakfast starting at 7:30 a.m. If you are arriving with your child before 7:30 a.m., a parent/guardian must inform the staff member after signing in if their child will be purchasing a breakfast that day. If dropping off your child after 7:30 a.m., the person dropping off your child will need to stop in the office to purchase the breakfast, and your child will take it with him/her to enjoy in the Saints Club room. Students attending morning child care will have until 8 a.m. to enjoy their breakfast in the child care room.
- K-2 students who do not attend before-school child care are also eligible to purchase a breakfast. Because your child will not be walked into school by an adult, we want to make sure you are aware that your child is charging a breakfast to their account. Please inform Amanda Cusack (acusack@asagr.org or 616-447-2997) if you would like your child to purchase breakfast. She will gather more information from you to ensure your child purchases breakfast on the days you intend your child to. All K-2 students purchasing a breakfast should arrive at the school office between 8:00 a.m. and 8:05 a.m. to pick up their breakfast.

Students will have until 8:18 a.m. to eat their purchased school breakfast in their classroom. Each morning, all K-2 students will continue to have a snack time during their morning routine. Please continue to send a morning snack with your child daily.

At the Upper Campus, breakfast is available in the cafeteria from 7:50 a.m. to 8:05 a.m.

- Students arriving at the Upper Campus can purchase their grab-and-go breakfast in the cafeteria starting at 7:50 a.m.
- Students who arrive at the Upper Campus via shuttle bus, and have not already purchased breakfast at the Lower Campus, may purchase their grab-and-go breakfast in the cafeteria upon arrival.
- Students will be permitted to eat in the cafeteria until 8:05 a.m., at which time they will be dismissed to their classrooms. Students may finish their breakfasts in their classrooms.

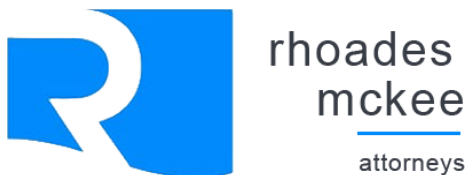
